Show Rules

Exhibiting

- The show is open to local residents and entries must be made in the name of the person who grew/made them.
- All flowers, trees, shrubs, fruit and vegetables must be grown by you. The only exception is in the flower arranging, where you can use materials to hand or that you have bought unless otherwise specified.
- The Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage.

Judging

- The judges' decisions are final in all cases.
- If there are insufficient entries in any one class, one or more prizes may be withheld. The judges are not obliged to award prizes where they think they are not merited.

Prizes and Cups

- You may enter more than one exhibit in a class, but you can only win one prize in any class.
- Prize money in each class is as follows: 1st - £1.50, 2nd - £1, 3rd - 50p.
- If you win a cup, we thank you for looking after it carefully during the year that you hold it. Some traditional silver polishes can erode the silver, so please use only a clean duster or a gentle silver cleaner.

Photography - additional rules

ALL PHOTOGRAPHS MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE VILLAGE HALL BETWEEN 6PM AND 8PM ON FRIDAY 6th APRIL.

- ✓ Maximum of two entries per person. You can win only one prize.
- ✓ Each photograph to be no larger than 15cmx10cm (6" x 4") and not mounted or framed.
- ✓ Editing is to be limited to cropping and brightness/contrast control. Any photograph that shows any other digital adjustments will be ineligible.
- ✓ Entrant's name and address must be on the reverse of the picture (not the front).

Entering and Cut-off Times

- Bring your completed entry form with your entry fees to the Village Hall **on Friday 6th April between 6 and 8 pm.**
- Photographs must also be delivered to the village hall between 6pm and 8pm on Friday 6th April. Bring all other exhibits on Saturday morning (see below).

Setting Up on the Day - Please bring your exhibits to the Village Hall on Saturday morning between 9 and 11 a.m.

- Make sure you have the correct number or size of items for each class.
- You will be given an exhibitors card for each of your entries. Place your exhibit and card in the appropriate class section, with your name facing down. We can help with any questions you have about how to display your entries.
- Set up your entries before 11am when the Hall will be closed for judging.

We respectfully ask that you do not remove your exhibits until after the awards have been presented at 4.30pm

To encourage the participation of novice exhibitors and people new to the villages we have introduced a new cup in memory of Harry Bryan, former Chairman and long-serving member of the committee.

'The Harry Bryan Memorial Trophy' will be awarded to the person most successful (based on most prize money and/or quality of entries) in the adult classes who has not previously entered more than one of our shows.

A. Flowers, Containers and Rhubarb

1. Five stems of trumpet daffodils
2. Five stems of narcissi
3. Five stems of miniature narcissi or daffodils
4. Five tulips
5. Five stems of hardy polyanthus
6. Five spikes of wallflowers
7. Five anemones
8. Five pansies
9. Container of flowers of one kind, excluding those above
10. Container of rock garden flowers, three kinds
11. Container of flowering shrubs/trees
12. One indoor pot plant
13. One outdoor planted container
14. Three sticks of rhubarb, without leaves

☆ 'Challenge Cup' awarded for most prize money in this section

☆ Diploma awarded for best exhibit in this section

B. Floral Art

15. 'Spring Celebration', frontal arrangement, maximum 61cm/24" wide
16. Arrangement of five flowers of one kind, any foliage
17. 'Spring Colour', using material from your own garden, table arrangement, not exceeding 46cm/18" overall
18. Arrangement in a cup and saucer, maximum 20.25cm/8" wide
19. Miniature garden in a seed tray (watertight)

☆ 'Oldham Cup' awarded for most prize money in this section

☆ 'Certificate of Merit' awarded for best exhibit in this section

C. Cookery

20. Jar of marmalade
21. Jar of chutney
22. Jar of lemon curd
23. An orange cake, copy of recipe used to be displayed with entry
24. 2 vegetarian pasties using homemade shortcrust pastry
25. 4 pieces of flapjack
26. A focaccia loaf using 125g/4.5oz flour

☆ 'Granville Cup' awarded for most prize money in this section

Cookery Guidelines

The cookery judge is guided by the WI guidelines to be found in their handbook "On with the Show". The judge may award up to 60% of marks for the flavour of baked items and up to 35% for flavour in preserves.

- Preserves (jams, jellies and marmalade)
 - ✓ Jars with a threaded top should have a new twist top only.
 - ✓ Jars with a plain rim should have snap tops or wax disc with cellophane cover.
 - ✓ Jars should be filled to within 3mm ($\frac{1}{8}$ inch) of top.
 - ✓ Jars and lids should not be branded in any way.
 - ✓ All jars must be labelled with content and day, month and year of making
- Chutney
 - ✓ Should be at least 2 months old
 - ✓ Jars should be sealed with new vinegar-proof lids e.g. plastic lined screw top
- Lemon Curd
 - ✓ Cellophane tops with a rubber band should be used
 - ✓ Wax discs should be an exact fit

28. A decorated hard-boiled egg
29. A portrait of 'a celebrity', on A4 paper, any medium
30. 3 decorated homemade cupcakes
